Arrest made in carjacking investigation

Adams County, Colo. (June 4, 2020):

The Adams County Sheriff's Office reports the arrest of two persons subsequent to a homicide investigation.

On May 31st at approximately 2:08 AM, deputies responded to the 8100 block of Brighton Road for a report of a deceased adult male in a driveway. Upon arrival, deputies located an adult male deceased from an apparent gunshot wound to the head. The victim was identified as 34-year-old Quincy Brewer of Highlands Ranch.

The ACSO Laboratory and Crime Scene Team responded to the location to process the scene. Detectives have conducted an extensive investigation which included the interview of multiple persons, the execution of several search warrants and the seizure of vehicles and electronic devices. The investigation revealed the victim was shot while sitting in a vehicle with the suspects in front of 8141 Brighton Road. Detectives have arrested the listed defendants and requested the following charges:

Maquala Ranee Glenn, 23 (Homeless)

- Murder 1st degree, a class 1 felony
- Tampering with Physical Evidence, a class 6 felony

Estevon Isaiah Garcia, 27, AKA: "Statick B", of Thornton, member of the BLOODS criminal street gang

- Murder 1st degree, a class 1 felony
- Tampering with Physical Evidence, a class 6 felony

The defendants are held in the Adams County Detention Facility pending further court proceedings. ACSO detectives were assisted in the investigation by the RAVEN (Regional Anti-Violence Enforcement Network) task force. The ACSO participates in the RAVEN task force which investigates and suppresses gun and gang violence in the metro area.

The Adams County Sheriff's Office or North Metro Drug Task Force has determined that there is probable cause to make an arrest. The defendant(s) are presumed innocent until convicted in court. The 17th Judicial District (District Attorney) may decline to prosecute or refuse to file charges in this proceeding. Consequently, charges are often reduced, dropped or dismissed.
