Arrest made in hit & run death

Adams County, Colo. (March 6, 2020):

The Adams County Sheriff's Office have made an arrest in the "Hit and Run" death of Garrett Arnold that occurred around East 104th Avenue and Headlight Road near Strasburg.

On October 12th, 2019 at approximately 4:40 a.m., deputies responded to 911 calls reporting an adult male in the roadway who appeared to be unconscious and unresponsive. The arriving deputies determined that the male was deceased and had been struck by a vehicle. David Lane Allen, 22, of Strasburg was taken into custody that day but was subsequently released pending further investigation.

Detectives conducted an extensive investigation with the assistance of investigators from Colorado State Patrol. Detectives recently concluded their investigation and an arrest warrant was issued for Allen. Allen surrendered to deputies at the Adams County Detention Facility on Thursday March 5th, 2020. Allen is charged with the following:

David Lane Allen, 22, of Strasburg:

- Leaving the Scene of an Accident Involving Death, a class 3 felony

The defendant was held on a \$20,000 cash bond in the Adams County Detention Facility pending further court proceedings.

The Adams County Sheriff's Office or North Metro Drug Task Force has determined that there is probable cause to make an arrest. The defendant(s) are presumed innocent until convicted in court. The 17th Judicial District (District Attorney) may decline to prosecute or refuse to file charges in this proceeding. Consequently, charges are often reduced, dropped or dismissed.
