Carjacking Investigation

Adams County, Colo. (April 7, 2021):

The Adams County Sheriff's Office is asking for the public's help to identify a suspect in a "carjacking".

Detectives from the Adams County Sheriff's Office are investigating a "carjacking" in the 7000 block of Pecos Street.

On April 5th, 2021 at approximately 11:53 p.m., deputies responded to the parking lot of an apartment complex at 7050 Pecos Street for a reported "carjacking". Upon arrival, deputies made contact with the victim in front of an apartment building. A preliminary investigation revealed that the victim was seated in their vehicle when an adult male suspect approached, pointed a large frame semi-automatic handgun at the victim and demanded the vehicle, a blue 2018 Jeep Renegade. The victim exited the vehicle and ran toward the apartments. The suspect then entered the vehicle and drove away at a high rate of speed. Detectives responded to the scene to interview witnesses, the victim, and others. This investigation is preliminary and ongoing.

The suspect is described as a Hispanic male, 30-40 years old, short in height, heavy build, wearing a light gray plaid jacket and a light-colored baseball cap. He was armed with a large black handgun.
