Road rage shooting investigation

Adams County, Colo. (June 30, 2020):

The Adams County Sheriff's Office is investigating a "road rage" shooting that occurred on I-76 between Federal Boulevard and Sheridan Boulevard.

On June 29th, 2020, at approximately 6:20 p.m., deputies responded to a report of a shooting at I-76 and Federal Boulevard. Upon arrival, deputies contacted two male juvenile victims. A preliminary investigation revealed that the victims were driving south on Federal Boulevard just north of I-76 when a tan, early 2000's Cadillac Deville with aftermarket black wheels and temporary Colorado tags, approached. The male driver pointed a black, large-frame, semi-automatic handgun at the victims. The victims entered the ramp to I-76 West and the driver of the Cadillac fired several shots which struck the victims' vehicle. The Cadillac then pulled alongside the victims' vehicle and fired again. The victims pulled onto the shoulder and the Cadillac fled the scene west on I-76. Neither victim was struck by gunfire. The ACSO Laboratory and Crime Scene Team responded to the location to process the scene. Detectives are currently attempting to locate any video of the incident.

The suspects are described as:

- Driver: White or Hispanic male, early 30s, thin build, tattoos on neck and arms, wearing a black flat brim hat with a red stripe, bald head
- Passenger: Hispanic female, late 20s, medium build, tattoos on right arm, with her hair in a ponytail
