## Search for Robbery Suspect

Adams County, Colo. (April 16, 2021):

The Adams County Sheriff's Office is asking the public for any information that may help us arrest a robbery suspect.

On April 15th, 2021 at approximately 7:35 PM, deputies responded to a reported armed robbery at the Berkley Village Liquor Store at 5302 Sheridan Boulevard. A preliminary investigation revealed that an adult male suspect entered the store, asked for some specific items, then displayed a black handgun and demanded the cash in the register. The clerk complied and the suspect fled in an unknown direction. Detectives responded to the scene to interview witnesses, the victims, and others. This investigation is preliminary and ongoing.

Suspect: Hispanic male, medium height, obese build, wearing a gray sweatshirt with red sleeves, blue jeans, a black mask and black gloves, armed with a black handgun.
