Shooting and Attempted Murder

Adams County, Colo. (March 8, 2021):

The Adams County Sheriff's Office is investigating a shooting and attempted murder.

On March 5th, 2021 at approximately 8:44 PM, deputies responded to the area of 76th Avenue and Pecos Street for a report of a motor vehicle accident and two persons with gunshot wounds. Upon arrival, deputies observed a red Nissan Sentra that had apparently struck a utility pole. Further, an adult male was outside the vehicle on the pavement with gunshot wounds to the chest and abdomen. An adult female was located in the driver's seat with an apparent gunshot wound in the hip area. The victims were transported by EMS to Denver Health for treatment of life-threatening injuries. The ACSO Laboratory and Crime Scene Team responded to the location to process the scene. Detectives responded to the scene and continue to interview witnesses, victims, and others. Detectives believe the shooting occurred in an area close to the scene of the crash. This investigation is preliminary and ongoing.
