Solved Homicide

Adams County, Colo. (November 27, 2021):

The Adams County Sheriff's Office report the arrest of an Adams County man in the homicide of his girlfriend that occurred in the 12800 Block of Picadilly Rd.

On November 27, 2021 at approximately 1:30 a.m., deputies responded to the area of E. 128th Ave. and Picadilly Rd. for a report of an adult female with a gunshot wound. Upon arrival, deputies encountered an adult female inside the front passenger seat of a red sedan, conscious and breathing, with a gunshot wound to the abdomen. The female was transported to a hospital for treatment but shortly thereafter succumbed to her injuries.

Deputies responded to a known address of the suspect and were able to take the male into custody.

Jeffery Aschenbrenner (DOB 3/1/88) was booked into the Adams County Detention Center pending multiple felony charges to include First Degree Murder.

The Adams County Sheriff's Office or North Metro Drug Task Force has determined that there is probable cause to make an arrest. The defendant(s) are presumed innocent until convicted in court. The 17th Judicial District (District Attorney) may decline to prosecute or refuse to file charges in this proceeding. Consequently, charges are often reduced, dropped or dismissed.
