## **Stabbing investigation**

Adams County, Colo. (January 23, 2020):

The Adams County Sheriff's Office is investigating a stabbing that occurred in the area of 74th Place and Kearney Street.

On January 23rd, 2020 at approximately 11:10 a.m., deputies responded to 911 calls reporting an adult male with a knife wound in the 6000 block of 74th Place. A preliminary investigation at the scene revealed that an occupant of a residence (victim) was contacted by two unknown persons requesting to use the bathroom in his home. The victim refused and became involved in a physical altercation with both persons. A female assailant then produced a knife and stabbed the victim. The victim was transported to an area hospital for treatment. The victim was awake and talking prior to transport.

Detectives are currently interviewing witnesses and neighbors.
