You are invited to the 2024 Operation Freebird.

Adams County, Colo. (November 20th, 2024):

The Adams County Sheriff's Office, in partnership with Food Bank of the Rockies, will host the 20th annual Operation Freebird on November 23rd, 2024, at Mountain States Toyota (201 W. 70th Ave., Denver, CO) from 10 AM – 2 PM or until supplies last.

Operation Freebird will unite over 30 community partners to support people experiencing hunger in Adams County. Each family attending the event will receive a food box containing everything needed for a complete holiday meal, including a Butter Ball turkey voucher (which can be used for any Butterball product, like turkey). This event is expected to serve up to 1000 families on-site, and the food boxes will be distributed on a first-come, first-served basis.

In addition to food assistance, attendees will have the opportunity to receive free health screenings, dental screenings, vaccinations, mental health services, and various other Adams County programs for employment assistance, childcare programs, veterinary services for pets, and more. In our efforts to reduce hunger in Adams County, we have connected with multiple businesses and organizations in our community to ensure Operation Freebird is a success.

Sheriff Gene Claps said, "Operation Freebird is an incredible opportunity for the Sheriff's Office to collaborate with great partners like Mountain States Toyota, Food Bank of the Rockies, and other stakeholders to give back to our communities and help make these holidays special. This is also a great opportunity for our staff to connect directly with the community members they serve daily."

"Food insecurity here in Colorado has reached the highest level we've seen in a decade. Partnerships like this have never been more critical to ensure we can continue meeting the need for food assistance, especially during the holidays when a meal with family and friends means even more to our community members. We're grateful for the Adams County Sheriff's Office and Mountain States Toyota. 
